Dear praying friends,

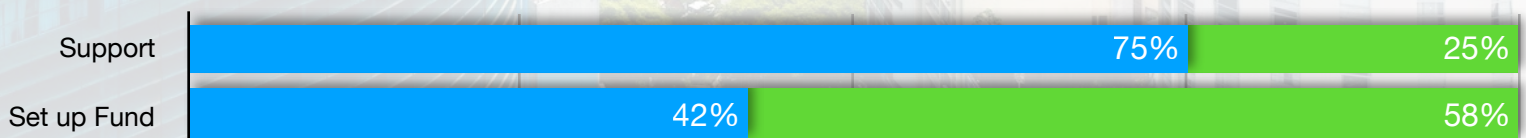
