Lord willing I'll be 100% back on my feet within the next few days. There is much work to do and the laborers are few - especially when the mosquitos take them out!

Our container of John and Romans and tracts should be headed our way shortly. We are very excited about receiving this material and using it for the furtherance of the Gospel here in Pinda. Bro. Allen Johnson with Wings Bearing Precious Seed is coordinating a trip to be with us from July 31 through August 7 of this year. This group will be here to distribute John and Romans, make personal visits, and be a part of our first anniversary here at Victory Baptist.
